

Web Tools | ACME

Acadia Course Management Environment is a program created by the AITT for use by Acadia University. ACME allows you to create online tests, have discussion groups, upload and download files, and return marks to students.

How are Acadia Professors using it?

ACME is being used to set up discussion groups for entire classes or for smaller groups of students. One way this can be used is to get feedback from students anonymously by getting the TA to monitor the groups and then creating a report for the Professor.

Faculty members are using the Notes section of ACME to post scanned articles for assigned reading or to post their class PowerPoint's for the students to use.

The Notes section is also being used for students to upload assignments. The section also has the capability to host group folders for group projects that are only accessible to those in the group.

Professors are also using ACME's Notes section to get to know their students by having them upload a picture of themselves along with a small biography.

The testing section of ACME is being used in the languages department to do weekly assigned quizzes, while other faculties are using the test feature to give their midterms.

The Grade Book feature in ACME is being used to return marks to students quickly and easily.
